

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE HEALTH PROJECT JAN 2006 – APRIL 2007

The figures below are the key combined monitoring figures from three health sites participating in the Domestic Violence Health Project – Charing Cross A&E dept., Parsons Green Walk-In Centre and Charing Cross EPCAS (the walk-in centre). Questioning and disclosure figures are for the two walk in centres only.

Training delivered from Jan 2006 – April 2007

Standing Together continues to co facilitate the Domestic Violence Protocol Training at Charing Cross Hospital A&E department, with the A&E lead. The protocol trainers for the walk in centres (developed by Standing Together in 2004/5) deliver protocol training to their new staff. Standing Together has reproduced the successful Protocol Prompt Card and when supplies were depleted we have re stocked the health sites and training materials as required. In October 2006 Standing Together produced and distributed Domestic Violence Protocol and Information Packs to EPCAS GP's and the Out of Hours GPS. In January and October 2006 Standing Together produced and distributed Protocol Information Packs for the Senior House Doctors at Charing Cross A&E Department.
