



Was a Domestic Violence screening question asked as set out in the protocol?

YES

Record reason why screening has not been conducted on the screening information recording box in screening book

NO, DV is not suspected

Was DV disclosed by the patient?

NO, but nurse is unsure if IPV is occurring

Record screening in book, and offer patient DV information.

In the screening book record that screening has been conducted, & the patient's response.

YES

Determine whether injuries need to be documented by a doctor

Outline treatment options to the patient in accordance with the protocol

Explain and complete IPV assessment proforma.

Offer reassurance and assess the patient's safety.

If patient agrees to attend Charing Cross A&E fax proforma & consider calling an ambulance to transport her as she may be in danger.

If danger/immediate threat to patient or staff is indicated. Call Security/Police & move patient to safety

In the screening book, record that screening has been conducted and subsequent action taken.

Inform patient about ADVANCE. Suggest/make a referral. Provide information if it safe to do so.
